1 Introduction

The PaNdata ODI web-site is based on a DRUPAL content management system. The site has been established at the beginning of the project in 04/2011.

The address of the website is <http://www.pan-data.eu>. It is hosted by STFC. The remainder of this report provides a brief update on the web-site content.

2 Updates

The content on the web-site has been continuously updated. All deliverables are available through the web-site under <http://pan-data.eu/ODIWP>, prominently linked under the Documents-tab.

All slides, reports and other materials from all events organized by PaNdata ODI are available through the site. Not all slides are deposited on the PaNdata site, but in most cases rather available on conferencing system guaranteeing long-term availability and indexing. Event organized by PaNdata ODI as well as events with contributions by PaNdata ODI are listed on <http://pan-data.eu/Events>. The site also lists selected events of direct interest for PaNdata topics.

PaNdata ODI runs a number of services and the consortium will continue offering the services beyond the scope of the project. The most relevant services are listed on <http://pan-data.eu/Services> and in the Services-menu.

PaNdata ODI is involved or running developments for the Umbrella identity systems, the ICAT data catalogue, standardized data formats (NeXus/HDF5) and applications like DAWN or MANTID integrating several of the aspects.

Tweets have been integrated in the PaNdata ODI site, and announcements about events, in particular about the bi-weekly CLNSF webinars are broadcasted via this channel.

3 Outlook
